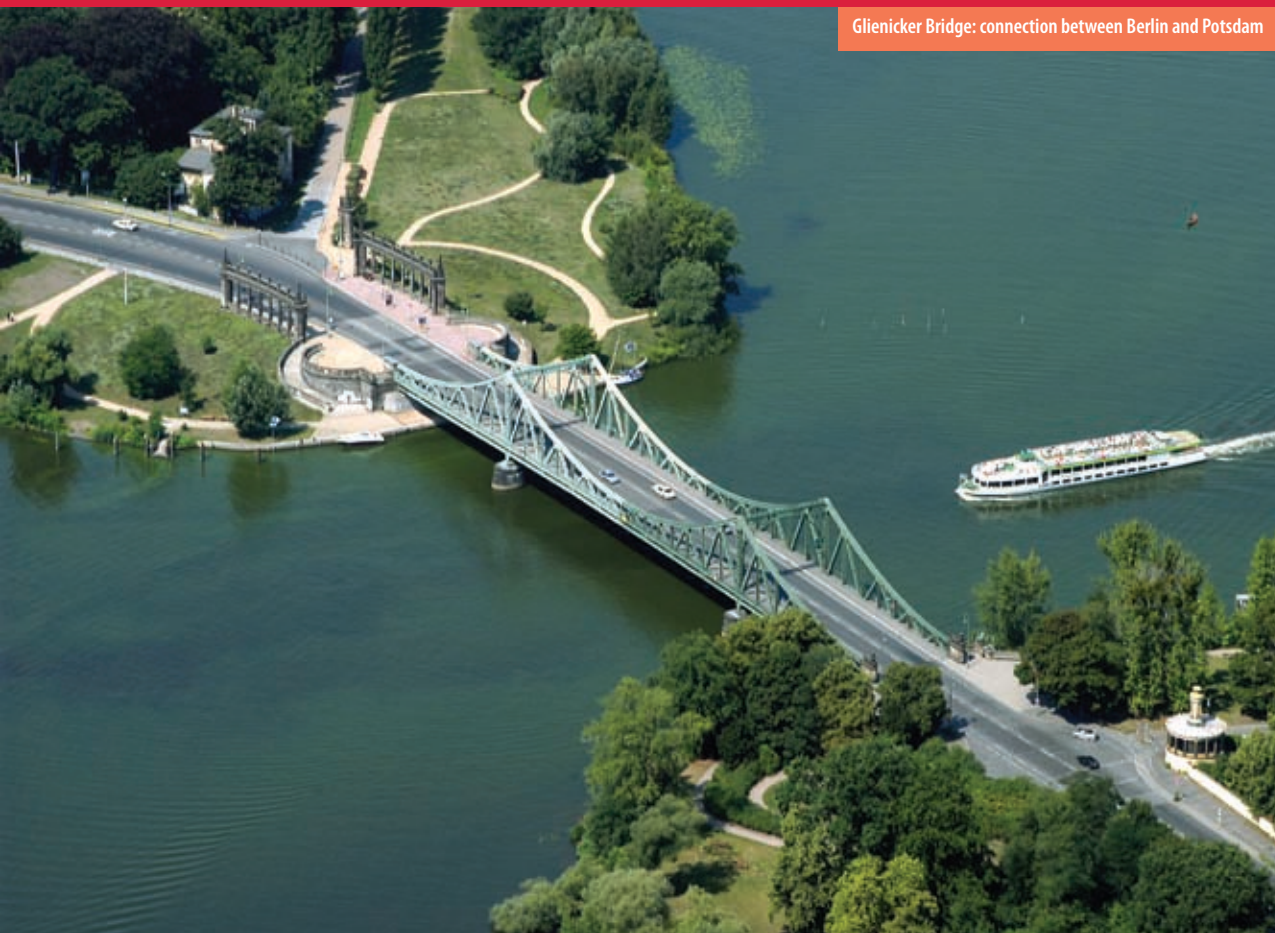
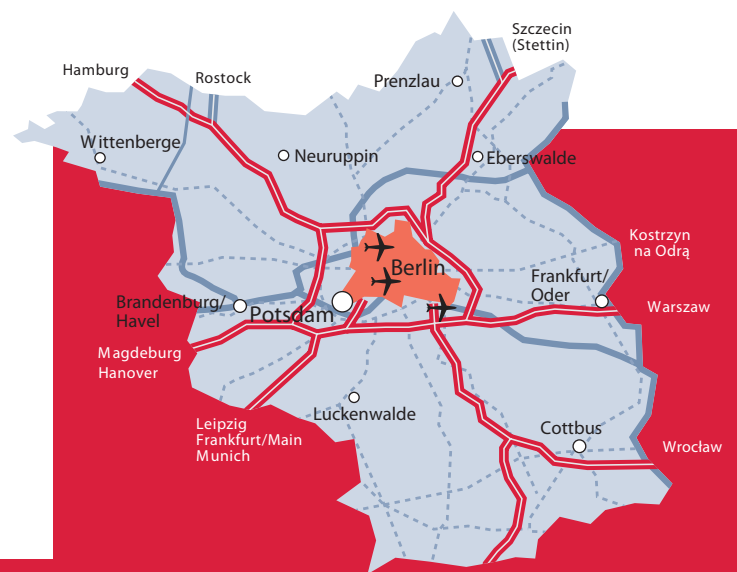
MODERN INFRASTRUCTURE

Rapid transit

The capital region offers very good transit connections in all directions: with a highly developed, modern network of highways, rails and waterways as well as international airports, Berlin-Brandenburg is exceptionally well-connected to the trans-regional traffic routes. Around 800 highways and 3,400 kilometers of rail ensure great mobility. The new Berlin-Brandenburg International airport, BBI, will particularly expand the access to eastern Europe and Asia as of 2011.

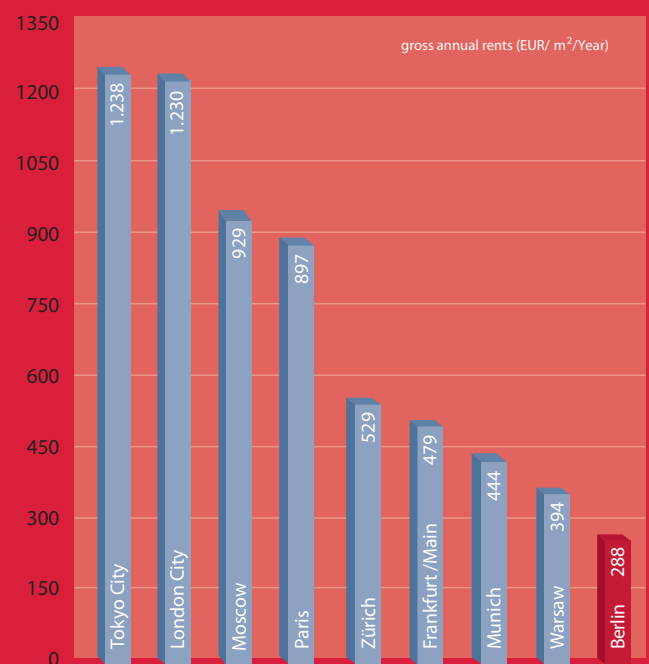

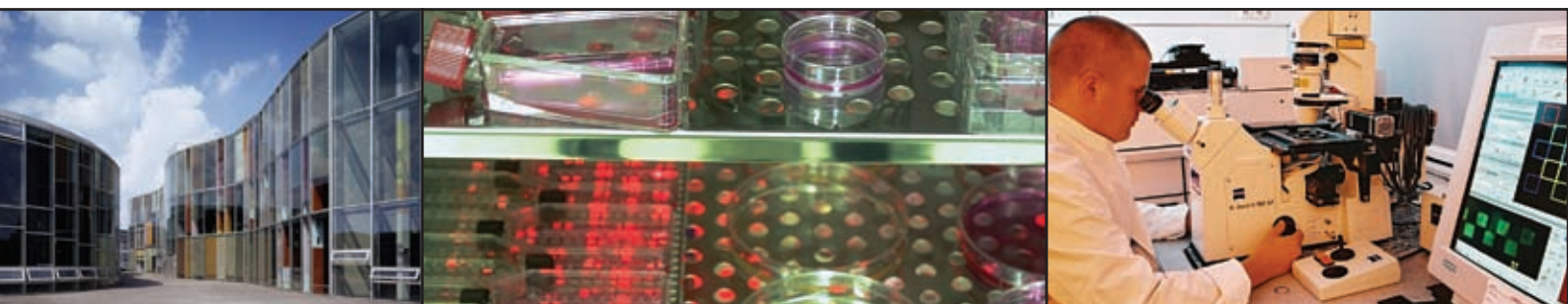
NUMBER ONE RESEARCH REGION IN GERMANY

Great density of research

Nowhere in Germany is there a greater density of research institutions than in the capital region of Berlin-Brandenburg. Seven universities, 21 technical and specialized colleges and over 100 extra-university research institutions offer a diverse arrange of opportunities for collaboration. Among them are the renowned institutes of the Helmholtz Society, the Leibniz Society and the Fraunhofer and Max Planck Societies (see page six for more).

Tightly networked

In Berlin-Brandenburg, economics and academics are in close cooperation. 42 technology parks and innovation centers offer you and your technologically oriented business tailor-made basic conditions. The numerous networks between businesses and research facilities are a particular strength of the capital region. They are to be found in Berlin-Adlershof, for example, as well as Berlin-Buch and the research area of Potsdam. Besides the institutes' transfer positions, you will also find two patent utilization agencies to support the transfer of knowledge.

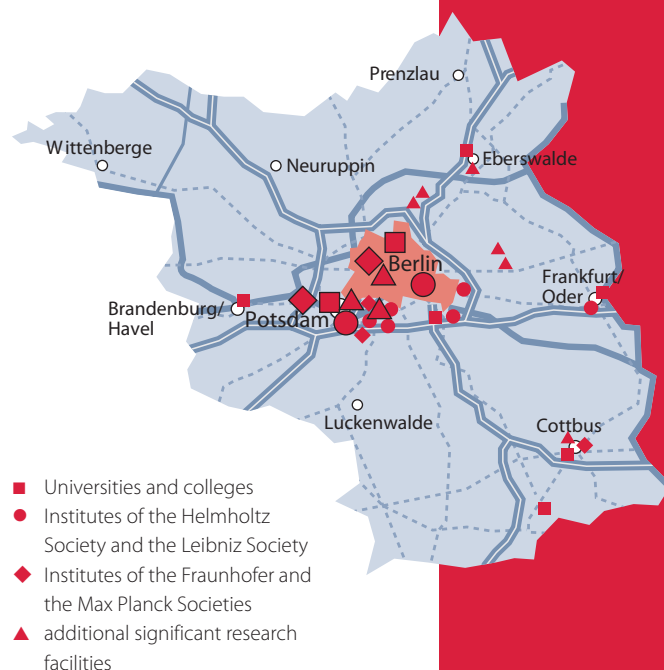

International orientation

At the colleges of the capital region you'll find the young academic talent for your business and have the opportunity to exchange knowledge with academics from all over the world. 40 percent of the students at the Europe University Viadrina in Frankfurt/Oder and more than 25 percent at the Brandenburg Technical University of Cottbus are from outside of Germany. The ESCP-EAP European School of Management is one of a kind in Europe, offering international courses of study across national borders. 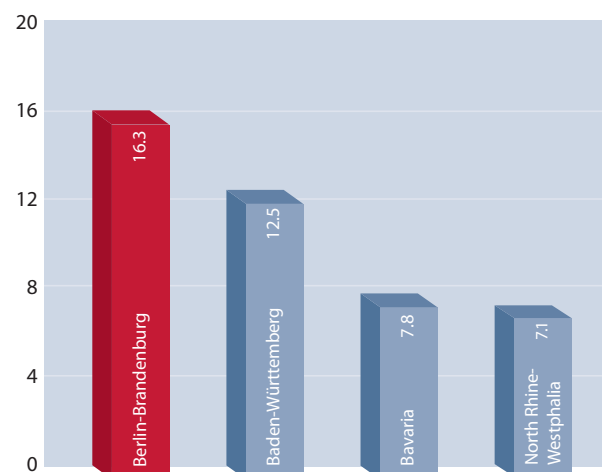

Best Assistance Measures in all of Europe

Berlin-Brandenburg offers investors the most advantageous assistance measures Europe wide. Large-scale enterprises may receive a subsidy of up to 30% on their investments, while small business may even receive subsidies of up to 50% on theirs. There are also attractive federal and state programs to provide assistance to R & D projects. Additionally, you will benefit from existing federal measures to spur the economies in the “new states” of the former GDR.

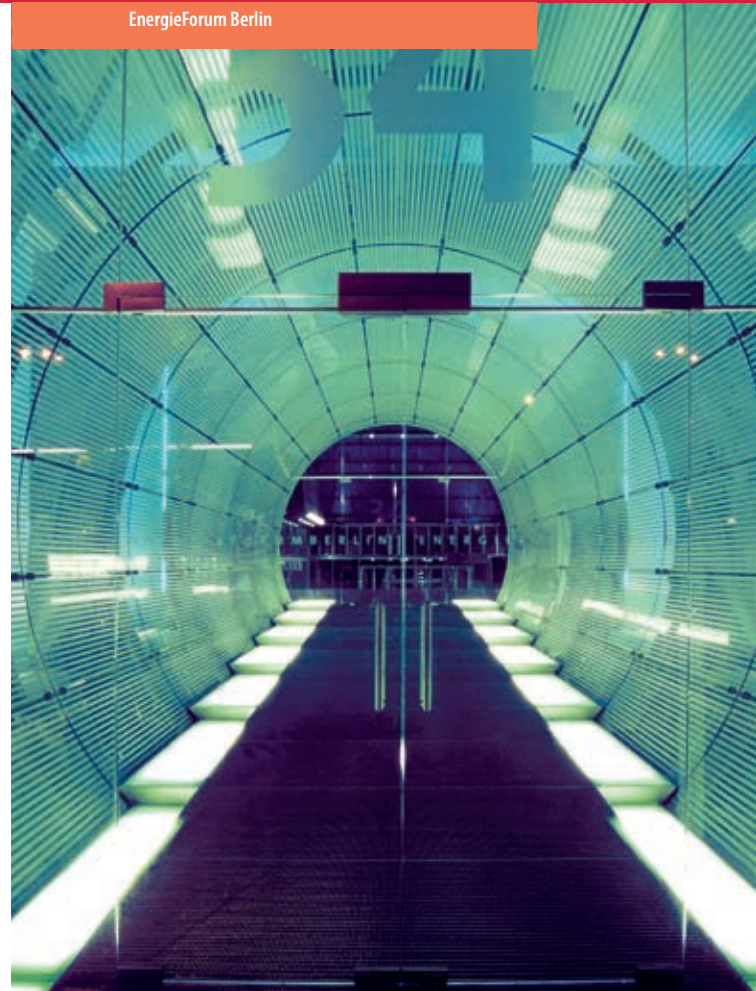

Simultaneously, the area's municipal trade tax rates are up to 20% below those of comparable regions in the west. A comprehensive view of all of the applicable taxes and social security contributions shows that enterprises operating in Germany carry a significantly lesser burden than do their competitors in France, in Italy, in Poland, and in the Netherlands.
